SELECTION CRITERIA

THREE letters of recommendation are required for each nominee

****Couples should be submitted as individuals and not together with each having separate applications and letters of recommendations.**

(No Photos of Nominees Will be Accepted).

Judging will be based on the **FOUR** following selection criteria.

1. Has Nominee exhibited community service, including civic activities? Explain how.
2. Has Nominee demonstrated love of country and/or community? Explain how.
3. Has Nominee exemplified the ability to embrace change? Explain how.
4. Describe action taken by Nominee in response to adversity (their own or others).

Each listed criteria will be worth 25 points. Omitting one could result in a lesser score, therefore affecting the overall score of your nomination. It is recommended to write out a letter of recommendation highlighting each individual criteria (4 criteria listed above) and how the nominee meets or exceeds it throughout their life or in their community.
