

# JEFFERSON COUNTY HIGHWAY

## 90 DAY LOAD LIMIT PERMIT

The Jefferson County Load Limit Resolution will be administered as follows:

The eight (8) ton load limit will go into effect January 15 and remain in effect until April 15 of each calendar year. Operation of any vehicle weighing over eight (8) tons during this time period on Jefferson County Highways will require a written permit from this office of the County Engineer of Highways, 750 Old Fairfield Road, Mt. Vernon, IL. The approval and/ or time period of the permits will depend on weather and road conditions and may be limited from a portion of a day to one week. Only during periods of adverse weather and road conditions will permits not be issued. Permits may be revoked at any time per the discretion of the Jefferson County Highway Department.

This policy applies to Jefferson County Highways only. When traveling on Township Highways, the Highway Commissioner in the Township involved shall be contacted for regulations governing travel on their systems.

There is currently no charge for permits issued at any time during the year.

It is not the intent of the Jefferson County Highway Department to prevent anyone from using Jefferson County Highways. We will make every effort to accommodate the needs of the Jefferson County Highway users. The intent is to preserve and protect the highways of Jefferson County.

The preferred method is to request the permit online.
