ABSENTEE VOTING NOTICE

CONSOLIDATED GENERAL ELECTION – APRIL 7, 2015

Connie Simmons, Jefferson County Clerk & Recorder, announces Absentee Voting requirements:

“Early Voting” will begin on Monday, March 23, 2015, and end on Saturday, April 4, 2015, at noon, except April 3rd which is a holiday. Early Voting will only be available at our temporary polling place, County Clerk’s Annex Office, 100 South 10th Street, Room 105A, Mt. Vernon, Illinois, from 8:00 a.m. until 4:15 p.m., Monday thru Friday, and Saturdays, March 28th and April 4th from 8:00 a.m. until 12 noon.

In-Person absentee voting will be conducted from February 26, 2015 – March 20, 2015, Monday through Friday, and on Monday, April 6, 2015, from 8:00 a.m. until 4:15 p.m.

Absentee ballots will be mailed out upon receipt of a signed absentee application starting on Thursday, February 26, 2015 – Thursday, April 2, 2015.

State Law prohibits anyone who votes absentee from also voting at the polls on Election Day, unless the absentee ballot is surrendered. All absentee votes will be counted after the polls close on Election Day.
