

## EARLY VOTING NOTICE

### Primary Election – March 18, 2014

Connie Simmons, Jefferson County Clerk & Recorder, announces Early Voting requirements:

“Early Voting” will begin on Monday, March 3, 2014, and end on Saturday, March 15, 2014, at noon. Early voting will only be available at our temporary polling place, County Clerk’s Annex Office, 100 South 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Room 105A, Mt. Vernon, Illinois, from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., Monday thru Friday, and on Saturdays, March 8<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. until 12 noon.

State law requires that a registered voter must show valid photo identification such as a current driver’s license, a State issued ID or other government issued ID with photograph before Early Voting. Voters are not required to offer a reason for voting prior to Election Day.

The law prohibits anyone who votes during the Early Voting Period from also voting at the polls on Election Day. Early Votes will be counted after the polls close on Election Day.
