

EARLY VOTING NOTICE

General Election – November 4, 2014

Connie Simmons, Jefferson County Clerk & Recorder, announces Early Voting requirements:

“Early Voting” will begin on Monday, October 20, 2014, and end on Saturday, November 1, 2014, at noon. Early Voting will only be available at our temporary polling place, County Clerk’s Annex Office, 100 South 10th Street, Room 105A, Mt. Vernon, Illinois, from 8 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., Monday thru Friday, and on Saturdays, October 25th and November 1st from 8 a.m. until 12 noon.

State Law has changed requiring photo identification for Early Voting; however, if the signature does not match you will be required to furnish identification. Early voters are not required to offer a reason for voting prior to Election Day.

The Law prohibits anyone who votes during the Early Voting Period from also voting at the polls on Election Day. Early Votes will be counted after the polls close on Election Day.
